ESCELCO has established an Integrated Management System through which it controls all actions with possible repercussions on the environment. One of the main bases of this system is respect for the environment through the prevention of pollution, within a framework of continuous improvement in accordance with current legislation. In order to comply with these requirements, ESCELCO requires that all companies carrying out work in its facilities accept a series of good practices as an essential prerequisite for their contracting, SUCH AS:

- Communicate any information and/or documentation that may be requested on the environmental aspects of their products and/or services.
- Communicate environmental incidents that are generated during the provision of their services that may pose a risk of pollution to the environment, as well as adopt the appropriate preventive and/or corrective measures, especially those related to avoiding/mitigating polluting spills and/or emissions.
- Avoid abandoning any type of waste, especially those defined as hazardous, and manage the waste generated during the provision of its services in accordance with current regulations, assuming ownership of the same and sending ESCELCO the documentation that guarantees its correct management when requested (e.g. treatment contracts, acceptance documents with an authorised manager, etc.).
- Do not mix wastes of different types, guaranteeing their proper segregation.
- If you supply a product to ESCELCO, you will communicate any potential environmental risk of the product and will send or provide the corresponding Safety Data Sheet of the products supplied.

Likewise, ESCELCO will take into account the implementation of good environmental practices in the development of its work, such as:

- Promoting environmentally friendly production processes and the implementation of Environmental Management systems.
- Reporting on environmental aspects associated with the material supplied.
- Reporting on corrective measures applied to reduce the environmental impact of the materials.
- Report on the waste generated by the materials supplied after their use and their characteristics, as well as their subsequent management.
- To notify ESCELCO of the environmental obligations derived from the regulations in force that would apply to the use of certain products.
- Use natural resources such as water, electricity and fuel rationally.
- Adopt the necessary measures to avoid abnormal noise.
- Avoid spills when handling hazardous substances.
